WHPS Procedure Summary 13.01: Case Staffing

In order to ensure program quality and consistency, case staffing meetings will occur at least weekly.

SUMMARY

- 1. Case Staffing
 - A. The Washington Health Professional Services (WHPS) Director assigns a case manager to all cases in development prior to offering a monitoring contract.
 - B. Case staffing meetings will be held weekly and as necessary.
 - C. Case Managers submit cases for review at each week's case staffing meeting. Cases for review include, but are not limited to: unauthorized substance use, material contract non-compliance (e.g., unapproved practice), contract amendments, etc.
 - D. If unavailable, the case manager assigns a substitute to present or provide a written summary with contract recommendations.
